<p>In English this term we will be reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Charlie and the Chocolate Factory</li> <li>- The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe</li> <li>- Pandora's Box</li> <li>- The Iron Man</li> </ul> <p>We will be creating our own narratives, sequencing stories, setting descriptions, writing newspaper reports and focusing especially on editing and improving our writing. In our reading session we will focus on retrieval, inference and summarising.</p>	<p>In Maths this term we will begin with re-capping our knowledge of place value. We will then focus on the four operations, using mental and written strategies to problem solve. Over the second part of the Autumn term, we will explore 2D and 3D shapes, their properties and how they can be classified. We will explore fractions and decimals and the link between the two. Towards the end of the Autumn term, we will analyse statistics, gather data and interpret data.</p>	<p>In first part of the Autumn term we will be exploring Electricity. We will be learning about how electricity is used to create energy, creating an electrical circuit, explaining how a lightbulb works, and identifying methods to use electricity safely. We will research the work and legacy of Benjamin Franklin and Thomas Edison.</p> <p>In the second part of the Autumn term, we will explore States of Matter. Making links to the water cycle, this will enable us to explain how evaporation and condensation happens.</p>
History	Geography	RE
<p>In History we will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons. We will explore the origins of the Anglo-Saxons, research how and why they invaded Britain and explore life during the Saxons, including religion and the jobs people had.</p>	<p>In Geography this term we will be exploring Extreme Weather around the world. We will collect information regarding specific events, sequence how these weathers are formed, and examine the effects climate change has on extreme weather.</p>	<p>In RE this term we will be learning about what it means to belong to Hinduism. We will explore the feeling of belonging to a religion and what this looks like. We will learn about Hindu beliefs, Gods and Goddess, and how Hindu's worship.</p>

<p>In Art this term we will learn about Surrealism. We will discuss what surrealism is, common themes in surrealist work and create our own surrealist artwork. We will create a balanced packed lunch, catering to the likes of pupils our age. We will complete market research, explore how food is preserved and how lunches vary across the world.</p>	<p>In PSHE this term we will discuss ways in which we can seek help when we need it. We will explore why it is important to ask for help, when it is necessary to ask for help and develop strategies to manage our feelings independently.</p>

<p>In Horticulture this term we will re-cap the Allotment rules, how we use the tools and equipment, and in particular how to do so safely. We will clear a vegetable bed for winter crops and collect seeds to sow and save.</p>	<p>In Spanish, we will re-cap prior learning including greetings, numbers and animals. We will then focus on how to address people differently based upon gender, age and job role.</p>	<p>In the first part of the Autumn term in PE we will focus on invasion games, developing our skills, resilience and teamwork. In the second half of the Autumn term, we will focus on competitive games, developing our striking, fielding, attacking and defending skills.</p>
