<p>In English this term we will be reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Journey to Jo'Burg - Billionaire Boy - New Kid <p>We will be creating our own narratives (build-up, conflict and resolution,) writing for a specific purpose (e.g letter writing,) grouping ideas into paragraphs. We will explore ways to edit and improve our writing. In our reading sessions we will focus on retrieval, inference and summarising.</p>	<p>In Maths this term we will begin with re-capping our knowledge of place value. We will then focus on the four operations, using mental and written strategies to problem solve. Over the second part of the Autumn term, we will explore 2D and 3D shapes, how they can be classified, and lines within different shapes e.g. perpendicular and parallel. We will explore fractions and decimals and the link between the two. Towards the end of the Autumn term, we will analyse statistics, gather data and interpret data.</p>	<p>In first part of the Autumn term we will be exploring Changing Materials. We will re-cap prior learning of materials and states of matter, and then use this to identify properties and uses of different materials. We will conduct investigations exploring reversible and irreversible changes.</p> <p>In the second part of the Autumn term, we will explore Earth and Space. We will identify the purpose of the Sun, Moon and Earth, and use this to describe the Moon's orbit around the Earth, and the Earth's orbit of the sun.</p>
History	Geography	RE
<p>In History we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will explore the role of the Pharaohs, life during Ancient Egypt, the influence of religion and the significance of Tutankhaten and Cleopatra.</p>	<p>In Geography this term we will be analysing Lines of Significance on Earth. We will locate significant lines on a map: equator, Tropic of Cancer and Capricorn. We will explore the properties of different climate zone and their features.</p>	<p>In RE this term we will be exploring what different religions believe about God. We will examine what Christians, Muslims, Sikhs and Hindus believe about God, identifying common themes ad beliefs. We will compare how God is represented.</p>

<p>In Art this term we will explore Ancient Egyptian art, linking to our learning in History. We will explore the meaning behind Ancient Egyptian symbols, using these to identify stories told through artwork. We will design and create art replicating Ancient Egypt themes e.g. pyramids, crowns and animals.</p>	<p>In DT this term we will be designing and making pizzas. We will research traditional Italian methods of pizza making and how these vary regionally in Italy. we will practise and refine our skills to improve our flavour choices. We will then design and create pizzas for different dietary requirements.</p>	<p>In PSHE this term we will explore how to be an active citizen. We will identify what an active citizen is, sharing and comparing the views of others in our class. We will discuss how our responsibilities, rights and duties play a part in us becoming an active citizen.</p>

<p>In Horticulture this term we will re-cap the Allotment rules, how we use the tools and equipment, and in particular how to do so safely. We will clear a vegetable bed for winter crops, collect seeds to sow and save, and learn how to harvest a variety of crops and how to store these.</p>	<p>In Spanish, we will re-cap prior learning including greetings, numbers, animals how to address people differently based upon gender, age and job role. Next we will focus on sharing our opinions when having a conversation, and responding appropriately.</p>	<p>In the first part of the Autumn term in P.E. we will focus on invasion games, developing our skills, resilience and teamwork. In the second half of the Autumn term, we will focus on competitive games, developing our striking, fielding, attacking and defending skills. This term we will also participate in both Swimming and Horse-riding..</p>
