<p>In English this term we will be reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Little People Big Dreams Rosa Parks - The Tunnel - Gorilla <p>We will retell familiar stories and identify the different elements of a story.</p> <p>We will explore setting descriptions and identify nouns and adjectives to describe a setting. We will describe a character using adjectives, adverbs and expanded noun phrases.</p>	<p>In Maths this term we will begin with re-capping our knowledge of place value including partitioning and comparing numbers. We will read and write numbers to 100 and will round to the nearest 10 and 100. We will then focus on the four operations, using mental and written strategies to problem solve. We will explore inverse calculations and arrays. Over the second part of the Spring term, we will explore 2D and 3D shapes, their properties and how they can be classified. We will sort shapes into Venn and Carroll diagrams. We will investigate regular and irregular polygons. We will recap different units of measure</p>	<p>In first part of the Spring term, we will be exploring what humans need to survive and create a life cycle of a human. We will explore the importance of a balanced diet and will explore food groups. We will create a food pyramid and describe the benefits of each group. We will explore what an animal needs to survive and will create the life cycle of an animal. In the second half of the Spring term, we will learn about the components of the water cycle. We will show this with a diagram and describe what happens in each stage. We will also investigate how quickly evaporation occurs.</p>

<p>In History we will be investigating what life was like in the 1600s. We will explain how The Great Fire of London began, spread and was extinguished. We will investigate the accounts of the fire from John Evelyn and Samuel Pepys and compare them.</p>	<p>In Geography this term we will be learning to identify the seven continents and the five oceans. We will locate different countries within Europe. We will learn about capital cities and locate different tourist attractions in the UK. We will be able to explain the purpose of the European Union.</p>	<p>In RE this term, we will be learning about Easter as a religious festival. We will explore the importance of Ash Wednesday and Shrove Tuesday. We will recall and sequence the events of Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. We will understand the importance of the Easter weekend for Christians.</p>
